

## Woodside School Sports Events

### Level 1 Events

A **Level 1** event is an event where local schools compete against each other. We have attended many of these.

KS2 Indoor athletics: There were 3 events and 14 children took part each time. We were the overall winners

KS2 Cross country: As of the 29th February 2016, there have been 2 local events where we have entered approximately 80 children each time. There are 2 forthcoming events in the Summer term. We have had individual successes at each competition.

KS2 Gymnastics: We entered 2 teams of 5 children. One team was competition winners.

KS2 Basketball: 8 children took part.

KS2 Tag rugby: 10 children took part.

KS2 Hockey: 8 children took part.

KS2 Football: 10 children will take part on 8th March 2016.

KS1 Gymnastics. The team finished in 2nd place.

### Level 2 Events

A **Level 2** event is an event where a school team competes against other school teams from a broader geographical location. These competitions are usually made up of teams who have had success in their own Level 1 competitions.

Our successful KS2 Indoor athletics team took part and were the overall winners. 14 children competed for the school.

KS2 Cross country: 10 children competed again with some individual success.

KS2 Gymnastics: 5 children took part and were good enough to progress to a Level 3 event.

KS2 Sports ability event. 6 children took part.

### Level 3 Events

A **Level 3** event is an event where successful teams from the previous Level 2 competition compete. The events tend to be a county wide competition.

KS2 Indoor athletics: 14 children have competed.

KS2 Cross country: 3 children have competed.

KS2 Gymnastics: 5 children have competed.
