

### Transition 2021

Dear parent/carer,

This year's transition work will again be slightly disrupted because of the unchanging guidance in relation to covid. Our current Year 6 children will unfortunately not be able to visit their new secondary schools, and parents/carers have received a letter from the Local Authority explaining this. Our usual transition work, where all children spend time with their new teacher, takes place while the Year 6s are at their new schools. Because of this not happening, our transition work will again be different.

Our new plans are outlined below:

Monday 5 July	10 - 11
Tuesday 6 July	9:30 - 11
Wednesday 7 July	9:30 - 11

The above sessions will take place in the children's current class bases but with their new class teacher and support staff.


On our return in September, we will use the same transition plan as this year.

**Day 1 (Thursday 02 September)** - The children will be met by the class teacher they have now on the playground, and they will spend the day in their new class base with them.

**Day 2 (Friday 03 September)** - The children will again be met by the class teacher they have now who will be with them until mid-morning when the new class teacher will take over.

New starters in Nursery and Reception will not start school until week 2 (Monday 06 September). This will be staggered as it was this year. Further details to follow.
