Information from Shropshire Public Health

Yesterday I received an update from the local authority regarding the situation with increased Covid cases in Shropshire schools. Shropshire's Director of Public Health has introduced increased local guidance as a result.

At Woodside, we are committed to keeping school life as normal as possible for our children. Keeping routines such as the one-way system, staggered start, finish and dinner times, which the children are used to, is working well.

We are continuing to allow outdoor events to take place at the moment but will be reviewing indoor meetings, clubs, wraparound care, etc., as we go.

At the time of writing this letter, we do not have any 'clusters' of cases in school. Please be assured that, in the event of a cluster of cases, we will be informing the relevant group/class following Shropshire Public Health advice.
